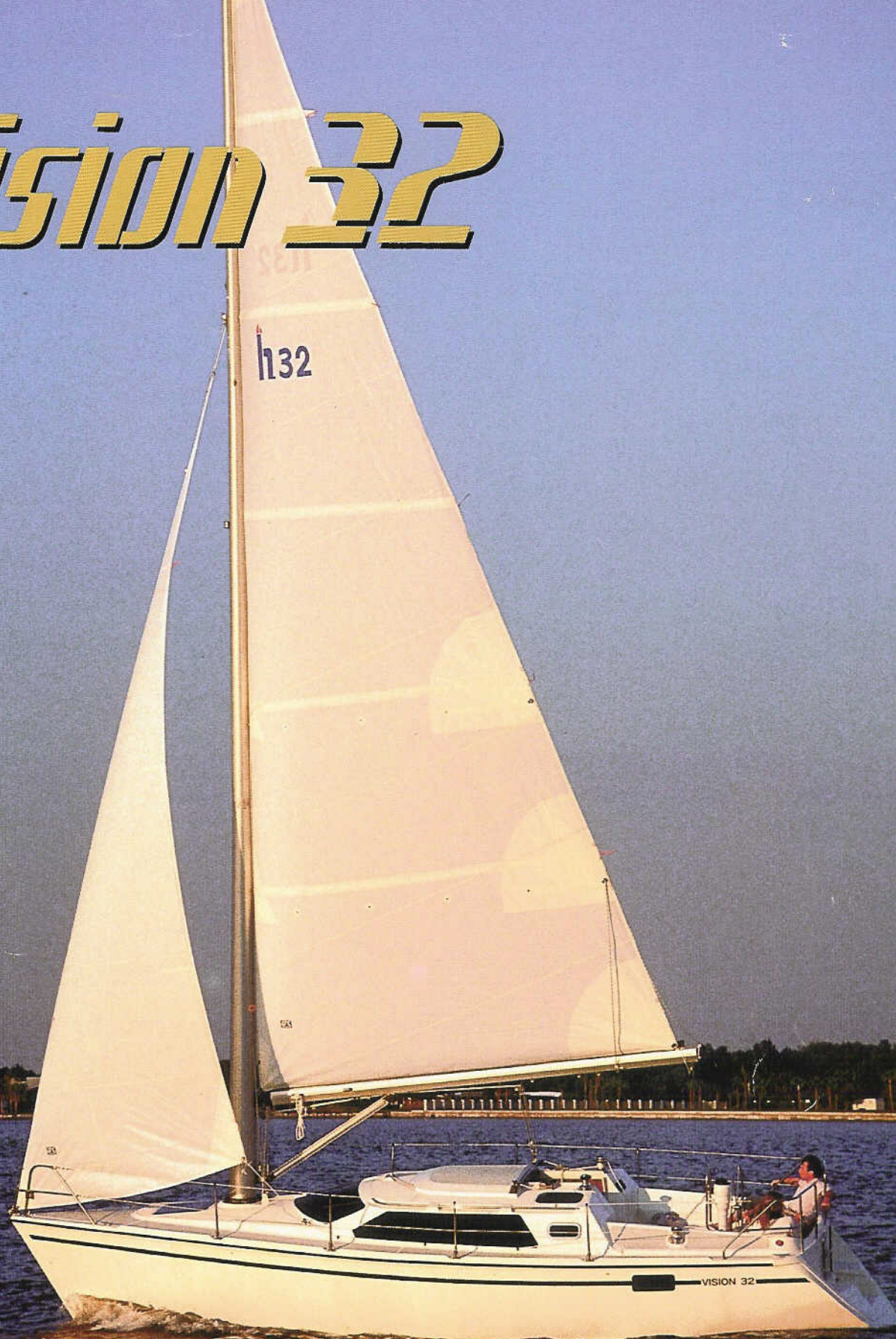

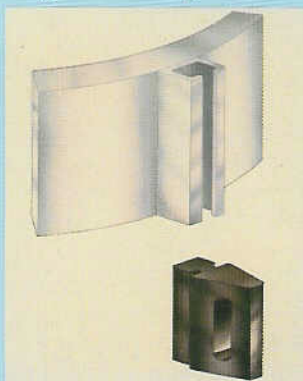
Tapered mast bends off, "spilling off" mainsail, lowering center of effort (CE) to increase stability.

Wide beam for increased stability.

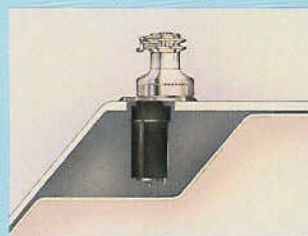
Large bulb lowers the center of gravity for increased stability.

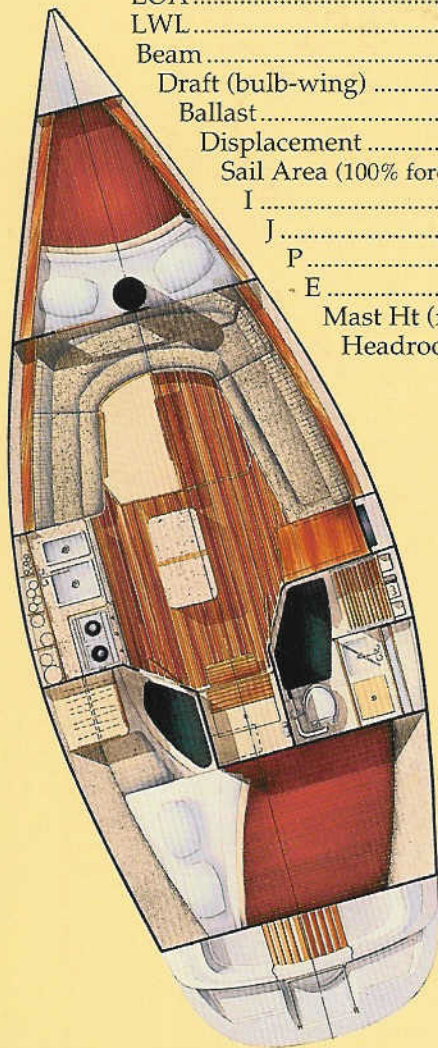
