

Warren Luhrs, Hunter's founder along with B&R Designs and the Hunter Design Team have combined to bring you the most advanced long-distance express cruiser. Born of singlehand around-the-world experiences, the HC50 is built to provide a fast, stable and comfortable passagemaker at reasonable production pricing.

# COMING SOON TO A PORT NEAR YOU.

The hull design has evolved directly from the successful singlehand offshore racer **Hunter's Child** and the innovative cruiser **Route 66**. Fully rounded sections allow for continuous shape above and below the waterline. This way the wetted surfaces do not change with the angle of heel, which reduces both the chance of broaching as well as weather helm. Vacuum bagging the high-tech laminates produces an extremely light structure that is exceptionally strong and very well balanced. The composite spade rudder and uniquely formed keel along with full water ballast allow for increased speed with the convenience of a moderate draft cruiser.

A powerful B&R rig includes a full battened, large roach main, a roller furled staysail, and a high clew headsail. A fixed-height boom, tripod mast system is designed to disburse the lifting and compression loads throughout the hull, eliminating point loading. The diagonal stays prebend the mast and assist in eliminating the need for a fixed backstay or running backstays. Steve Pettengill, Hunter's Child skipper and Hunter Marine's manager of offshore testing has the responsibility to design this boat with hardware that will withstand the rigors of the open ocean time and again. Safety, simplicity and performance are paramount!


Propulsion is accomplished with the standard 38 hp saildrive or the optional 47 hp model. All the ships services are directed from the fully-gimbaled navigation station. Great care and precision are taken in crafting the comfortable and functional interior. All amenities are present including a full-service galley with refrigeration, spacious day head and two guest/sea berths. The convertible work bench and tool storage is convenient and practical as is the plentiful storage. Forward is the master stateroom, complete with private head, separate shower and a centerline berth, making extended cruising a comfortable experience.
