

- 1. Locate the 7/8" hole on the starboard side of V-berth area approximately 6" down from the hull flange and 3" aft of the anchor well.
- 2. Clean the area and hardware with alcohol then using designated caulk (Page 1, #3) caulk around the hole on the outside and inside of the hull.
- 3. From the outside of the hull place vent in position.
- 4. From the inside of the hull place the designated wood doughnut in position.
- 5. Apply pipe compound to the male threads on the designated elbow then secure the vent in place by attaching the elbow (make sure the elbow end faces up).
- 6. Coat the male threads on the hose barb fitting with pipe compound then attach the hose barb fitting to the elbow.
- 7. Clean up all excess caulk with alcohol.
- 8. Attach the vent hose to the hose barb using the designated hose clamp.
- 9. Run the vent hose up about 5" and then back down to make a loop then loosely attach a tie-wrap around the hose and hose clamp to prevent the loop from coming undone.
- 10. Leave the other end of the hose loose as it will be attached with the water fill hose and together they will be run aft to the water tank.
