Preparation Of Deck Embossment

- 1. Grind the interior trim ring flush with the hull and break off the trim ring fasteners then grind them flush with the hull.
- 2. Make sure the window embossment is sanded properly, there should be no shiny areas.

Preparation Of Plexiglass Windows Fig. 2

- 1. Sand the outside edge of the window with 80 grit sandpaper to remove hairs from the window and paper.
- 2. Remove the paper from inside of the plexiglass window. (Beveled edge side)
- 3. On the beveled side of the window sand 3/4" around the edge with 80 grit sandpaper (There should be no shiny areas.)
- 4. Place the window in position (make sure gaps are even all the way around) then mark the mounting hole locations.
- 5. Remove the window and drill the marked locations using a 5/32" drill bit.
- 6. Clean the sanded area of window and hull with alcohol.

Installation Of Plexiglass Window Fig. 3

- 1. Apply a generous coat of designated caulk, page 1 #2, in the embossment. Make sure there are no voids or gaps (no white from the hull should be showing).
- 2. Press the window in place then secure the window to the hull using designated fasteners.
- 3. **Note:** Clean up excess caulk with a soap and water solution.
