
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356 PORT AND STARBOARD WINDSHIELD INSTALLATION





SAND OUTSIDE THE MARKED LINE WELL WITH 80 GRIT SANDPAPER

APPLY A THICK LAYER OF CAULK TO WINDOW EMBOSSMENT


- 1. Make sure the window embossments on the deck is sanded properly with 80 grit sandpaper, there should be no shiny areas.
- 2. Sand the outside edge of the windshields with 80 grit sandpaper to remove hairs from the window and paper.
- 3. Remove the paper from the inside of the plexiglass window.
- Have someone hold the windshields in the deck embossments making sure the windows are centered in embossments.
- 5. From inside of the deck mark the plexiglass windshields around the window opening with a pencil then mark the mounting hole locations onto the deck from the outside. Remove the windshield then drill the marked locations on the deck using a 5/32" drill bit.
- 6. On the windshields sand the area on the outside of the marked line with 80 grit sandpaper. (There should be no shiny areas.) (Figure 1)
- 7. Using an air nozzle blow down the deck area where the windshields will be installed.
- 8. Clean the sanded area of the deck and windshield with alcohol.
- 9. Call quality control for inspection before installation.
- 10. Apply a thick layer of black 739 caulk in the embossment, make sure there are no voids or gaps (no white from deck should be showing). (Figure 2)
- 11. Press the windshields into place then secure them to the deck using the designated fasteners. (Figure 3 & 4)
- 12. Clean up excess caulk with alcohol. (Figure 5 & 6)


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APPLY PLENTY OF PRESSURE ON WINDSHIELD TO FIRMLY SEAT INTO CAULK AND EMBOSSMENT THEN SECURE WINDSHIELD TO DECK WITH THE DESIGNATED FASTENERS



SCRAPE OFF EXCESS CAULK WITH A SQUEEGEE THEN FINISH CLEANING UP EXCESS CAULK AND AESTHETIC, SMOOTH FINISH WITH "MONKEY FUR" SATURATED WITH ALCOHOL
