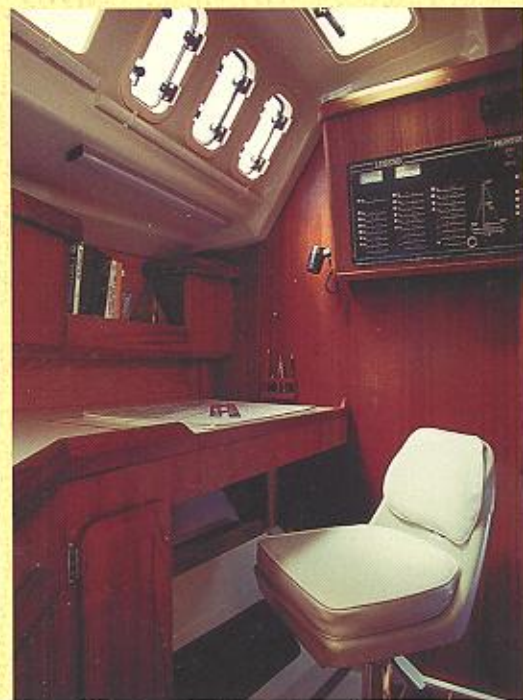

bulb-wing keel lowers the center of gravity to maximize stability and allow a generous sail plan.

The cockpit offers tremendous comfort and flexibility. Seating is wide and deep, and surrounds a combination helm station and cockpit table. The helm station includes knotmeter, depth sounder, compass, VHF radio, engine panel, single lever engine control and wheel brake - all standard equipment on the Legend 43. An added bonus is the ability to dine above decks, made possible by fold-up leaves, drink holders and seating for numerous friends. Also, the cockpit includes five storage lockers

for distant cruises, a walk-through transom, and a swim platform with hot/cold shower for swimming and diving. Plus, you'll enjoy easy access for safety and convenience from the water or dockside.

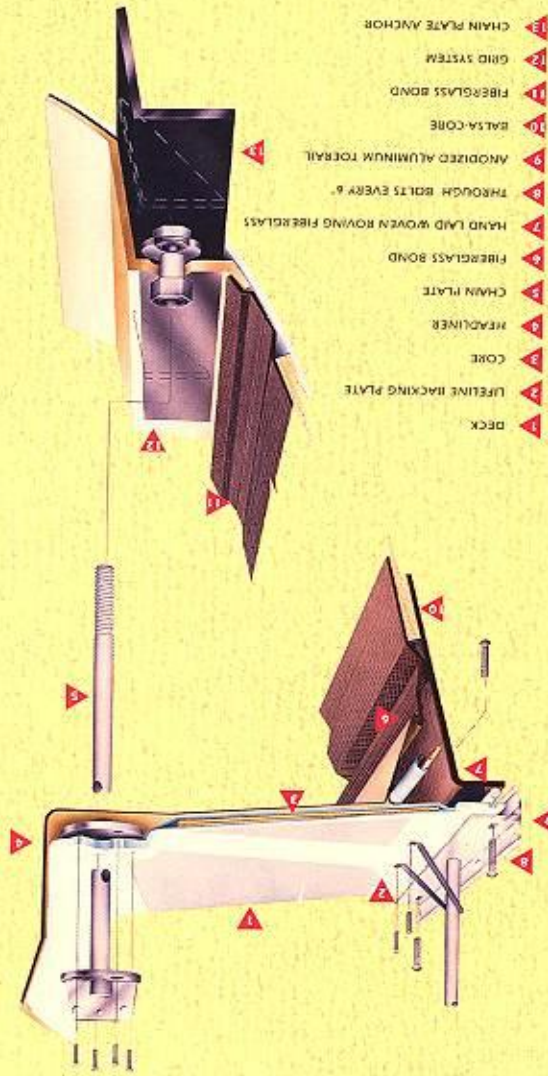

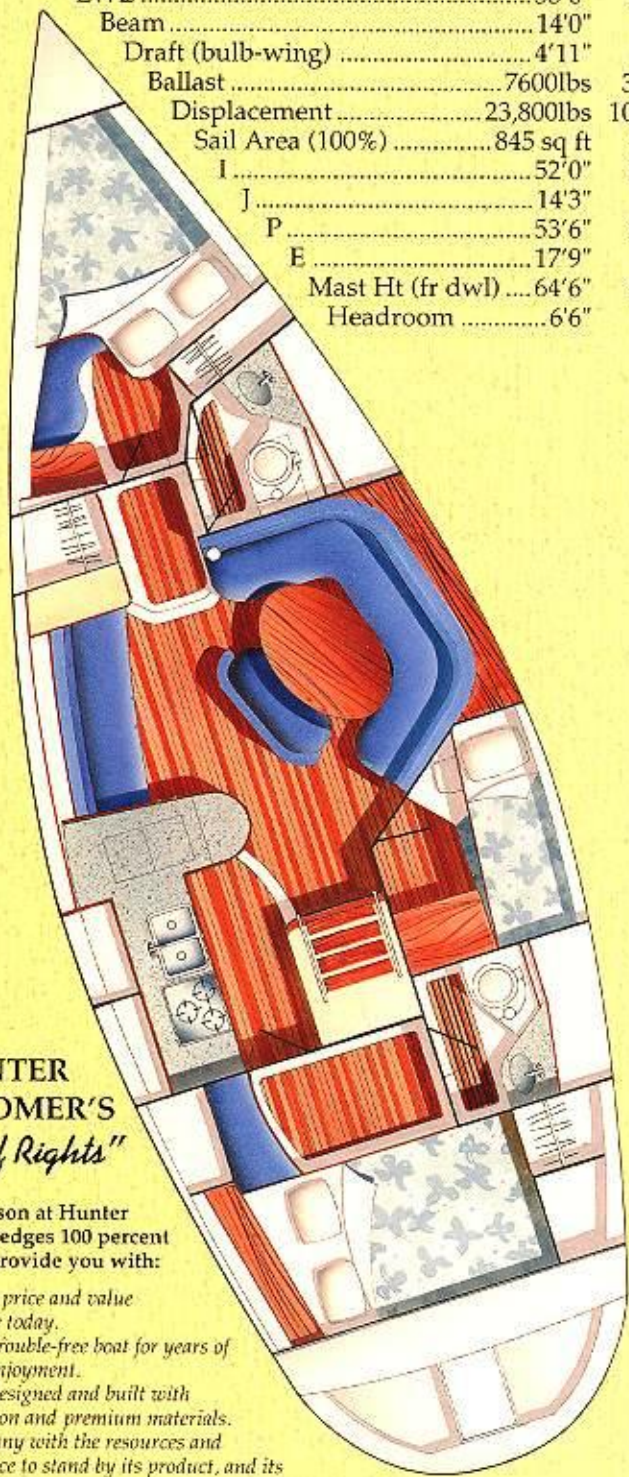
