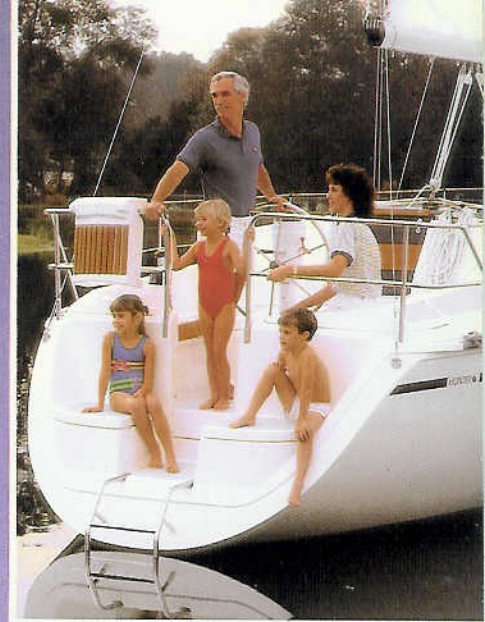

Removing the arched helm seat in the cockpit opens an innovative walk-through transom with storage lockers, steps, and an integrated swim platform making swimming, diving and snorkeling easy for your whole family. With the helm seat in place and the swim ladder raised, the cockpit returns to its full enclosure. You'll feel at ease at the helm equipped with pedestal steering and engine controls with lighted compass.

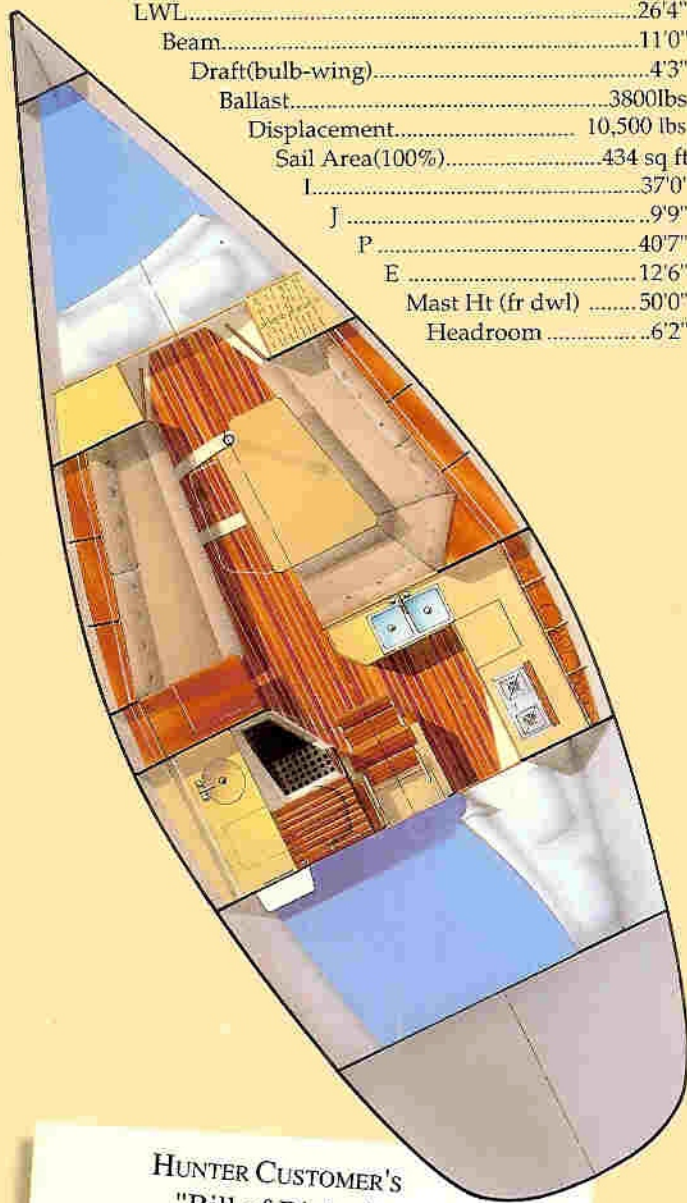
